ONE-HANDED ROLLING PIN

The common household rolling pin is useless for those having just one usable hand. There are special rolling pins built much like paint rollers for one-handed use, but these pose difficulties even in normal hands and are indeed unusable for the millions of people whose single "good" hand is weak or poorly controlled. **Our invention is usable even by most such people** - and by anyone else who just wants one-handed control...



Our handmade test piece - a first working mockup

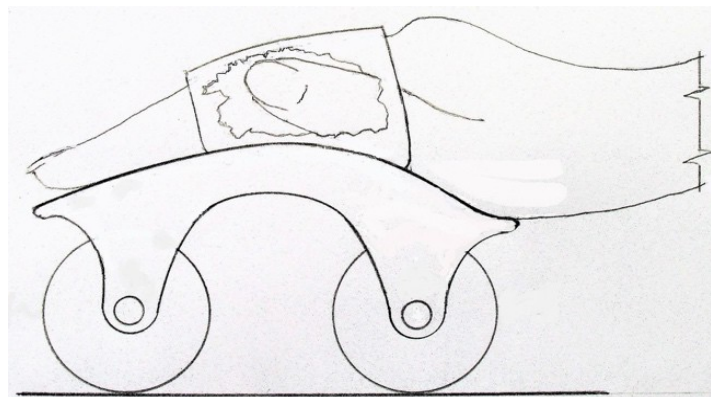
◀ - which really works...just one hand...dough stays flat..

But many prospective users have difficulty making a fist to grip around such a handgrip. So, this further design replaces it with a semi-rigid mitten-like "dock", enabling the user to insert an open hand and roll the rollers without needing to grip anything - and bringing the rollers closer together too ▼
